The conference will open with a welcome reception at the National Museum of Wales on the evening of Wednesday 24 March and an evening reception will be held on Thursday 25 March at Cardiff Castle where delegates will have the opportunity to have guided tours of the recently conserved interiors. On the afternoon of Wednesday 24 March delegates may also take advantage of an exclusive behind-the-scenes tour of the newly constructed Glamorgan Record Office in Cardiff before it opens to the public. Alternatively there will be a PACR clinic for PACR candidates at the National Museum of Wales.
