HLF Internships: New Routes into Conservation through work-based learning

Extension to original scheme announced

The Heritage Lottery Fund granted £1Million to Icon in 2005 to deliver a new internship scheme in conservation. This has helped 54 new conservators launch their careers over the last four years. In October 2009 HLF agreed to extend Icon's scheme up to March 2012, allowing Icon to offer another 20 placements - to be advertised in April and October 2010.
